


Nouns are the names of people, places and things/objects.


There are **different types** of nouns.

Today we are learning about **common nouns**.






A common noun refers to a general person, place or thing. It is not the one and only.

Some are bigger, some are smaller, and some are different colours.


There are many of them. Each bird is **not the one** and only!

Lady is a common noun.





Horse is a common noun.


The image below shows lots of different **things or objects**. A **common noun** names them in a **general** way.
