Children in Year 6 can volunteer to be a librarian in the school's central library. When volunteering for this role, the children are asked to fill in an application form stating who they are, what their interests are as well as explaining the reasons why they would like the job and the qualities they believe they could bring to the role.

Our Year 6 librarians value their role and carry out their duties responsibly by leading by example, treating the books and library space with respect and behaving in a respectful manner. The librarians' main duties include ensuring the library is tidy, the books are organised and that all returned books are placed in the correct location. The librarians also help teaching and support staff to locate books, organise books by level and recommended and find appropriate books for the younger children. The librarians have mentioned that their role not only facilitates their love for reading but has also helped improve their creativity, vocabulary, knowledge and overall writing skills in all subjects.
